

Authorization Consent Process

What is the Token Consent process?

- It allows you to authorize Hang Seng Bank to submit your MPF contribution data through Hang Seng Business e-Banking.
- It ensures that only properly authorized personnel in your company can handle MPF-related operations.
- You always retain control — you can view or withdraw your consent at any time.

How to start the Token Consent Process

- Begin the authorization process through the relevant link provided in Hang Seng Business e-Banking.
- The system will automatically redirect you to the eMPF Platform's Consent Portal.
- Log in using your employer account.
